Prices for clay targets – Discussion took place to try determine cost for the cards and maintain a fair price for the shooters. It was decided to keep same price.

A new shed is needed for the silhouette targets. Conversation started for estimating size, cost, and considering having a part of it insulated to use for shooting during the winter months. Norm and Jose measured the area. Jose is getting estimates.

New Business

The 4H Nationals State Shotgun team stopped by to thank the club for their contribution and support towards their trip to the National Championship in Grand Island, NE. They placed 5th team overall and said they had a great time and learned a lot as well.

Talked about buying cutouts for targets @ \$.20 lb from Summers Mfg. – Jose made motion to buy, Doug seconded and all voted in favor.

Mentioned the availability of a used Walther 300 for \$975 to use for Shooting Sports. – Purchased

Also made mention of another rifle available with an Air fill tank for around \$1000 – Rick made a motion to purchase, Darin seconded and all voted in favor.

Rick made a motion to purchase some youth shooting clothing and gloves from 10.9, José seconded the motion, all voted in favor.

Doug made a motion to build 3 new scoring chairs for the shotgun fields. Rick seconded, all voted in favor.

Discussion took place about range cleanup, a picnic, and the free sight in day. Cleanup and picnic was thought possibly 26 Sep and sight in the 27th.
